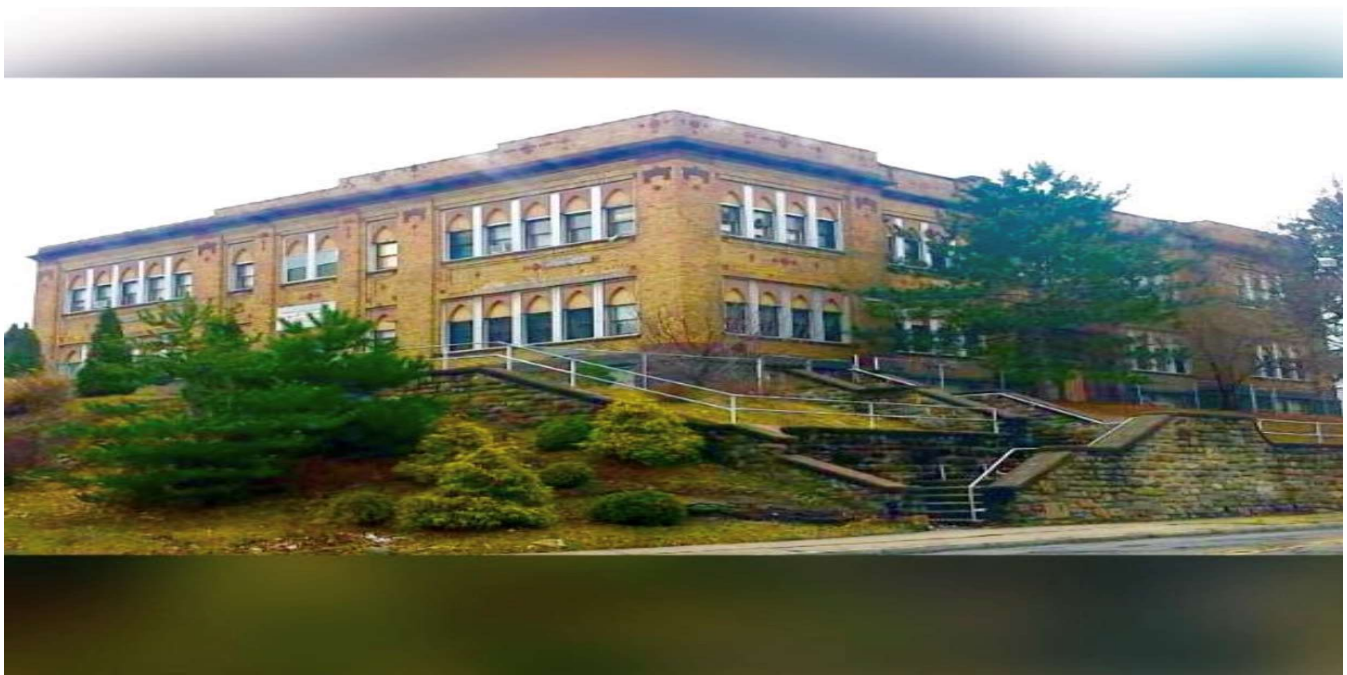

KG & Elementary Program:

ANIA program builds on the foundation of the Early Childhood program. Lessons are coordinated jointly to produce a student who can function proficiently in the next grade and to compare strategies and innovate new ideas. This is a continued evolution that requires care and wisdom to achieve the highest potential for all students. Our children are blessings from Allah SWT and our responsibility is to instill Al Quran Al Kareem and Al Sunnah Al Shreefah in their hearts to be fully aware and dependent on Allah SWT in their lives.

ANIA recognizes the innate and inherent needs of children. ANIA program strives to fulfill the needs of the child by targeting six basic areas of development: spiritual, psychological, emotional, social, physical, and cognitive development. Our curriculum is the same curriculum of Public Schools in addition to AlQuran AlKareem, Islamic Studies and Arabic language. We measure and monitor students' academic growth three times yearly: At the beginning of school year (BOY), at the middle of school year (MOY) and at the end of school year (EOY). ANIA students compete, also, with their peers in Public Schools having Pennsylvania State Standardized Assessment (PSSA) and making Terra Nova Standardized Test.
